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Closing & Feedback Meeting by Social Innovation and Cohesion Institute

The third Transnational Project Meeting, known as the Closing Meeting, was scheduled to take place in Thessaloniki on the 17th of February 2023. This meeting took place as a hybrid meeting using Zoom Platform for the organizations that were unable to attend in person. It brought together all representatives from each partner, with the following involved partner organizations such as Social Innovation and Cohesion Institute (Fifty-Fifty), Internationale Arbeidsvereniging (ILA), Asociacion Cultural Y Deportiva Lahoya, Centro Internazionale Per La Promozione Dell'educazione E Lo Sviluppo Associazione (CEIPES), Education And Active Learning (S.E.A.L CYPRUS), and Panellinos Sundesmos Epixiriseon Hlektronikon Efarmogon, Pliroforikis Kai Neon Texnologion (PSICT).

It was planned to be held during the final month (M22) of the project's implementation and spanned two days.
