BBX Across Europe

During 2025, BBX successfully delivered Multiplier Events in six cities, each contributing a unique local impact while reinforcing the project's shared European vision:

-  Sofia, Bulgaria
-  Germany
-  Thessaloniki, Greece
-  Veroia, Greece
-  Kozani, Greece
-  Lyon, France

Each event brought together youth communities, organisations, and stakeholders, highlighting how non-formal education and entrepreneurial thinking can shape new opportunities for young people across Europe.

What Happened at the Events

Across all cities, participants experienced a rich programme that included:

- ✓ Presentation of the BBX Xelerator Model Partners introduced the methodology combining non-formal learning, mentoring, digital education, and hands-on practice.
- ✓ Showcase of Youth-Led Projects Young participants presented business, environmental, and social innovation ideas developed during the BBX Xelerators—many of which continue to grow today.
- ✓ Interactive Workshops Sessions on ideation, problem-solving, pitching, sustainability, prototyping, and digital skills engaged participants in practical learning.
- ✓ Networking Opportunities Youth connected with local organisations, trainers, institutions, and potential collaborators, strengthening regional entrepreneurial ecosystems.
- ✓ Demonstrations of the BBX Digital Tools Attendees explored the BBX Platform, MOOC, educational resources, and the project's online learning environment.

Impact & Highlights

The Multiplier Events collectively achieved:

- Increased awareness of youth entrepreneurship and innovation
- Strengthened collaboration between youth organisations across Europe
- Engagement of young people with fewer opportunities, NEETs, and aspiring entrepreneurs
- Promotion of sustainability, digital readiness, and social responsibility
- New partnerships and follow-up initiatives inspired by the BBX approach

These events validated the BBX model as an effective and inclusive pathway to youth empowerment.

Who Took Part

The events brought together:

- Young people (ages 18–30) from diverse backgrounds
- Youth workers, trainers, and educators
- NGOs, community organisations & social innovators
- Local authorities & stakeholders from education and entrepreneurship
- Representatives of start-up ecosystems and innovation hubs

Across all cities, participation exceeded expectations, reflecting the growing interest in youth-led innovation.

The success of the Multiplier Events highlights the power of collaboration within the BBX partnership — organisations from Greece, Bulgaria, Germany, and France working together to support young people in shaping a greener, more digital, and socially inclusive future. 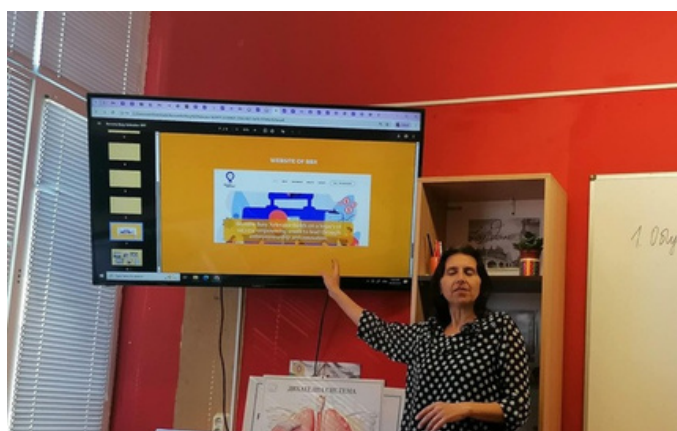
